Location:

@ Island Grove Regional Park

(NW Side of the Arena, under the Grand Stands – see map on last page)

501 N 14th Ave, Greeley, CO 80631

The trial will be held indoors and outdoors. It will most likely be HOT. Please be prepared. There will be no indoor crating. There may be some shade for crating but that is not guaranteed.

Disruptive dogs will have to be crated outside of the trial area. If your dog cannot handle other dogs or people walking past their crate, plan to crate outside the trial area. Please bring adequate shade.

There will be no electricity supplied. See map on last page.

Parking:

There will be parking allowed just outside the arena. However - DO NOT BLOCK THE FENCE OPENING IN ANY WAY. **Do not pull IN the fenced area.** Do not park in an RV spot unless it is your reserved RV spot. Do not block any other vehicles. You will be asked to move immediately.

Do not park in the line of sight of search areas.

Pay attention to marked areas so you aren't walking into / pottying your dogs in a search area!

Below please find the judge assignment changes. Exhibitors have the right to request a full refund of their entry fee for any classes affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day in which the exhibitor is entered.

Friday:

Container Excellent, Buried Excellent has moved to Deanna Bunn.
Interior Advanced, Exterior Advanced has moved to John Fisher.

Saturday:

Interior Novice has moved to Deanna Bunn.

Sunday:

Interior Novice has moved to Sally Dunphy.

Crating:

There will be space for crating outdoors. You can leave crates set up the rest of the weekend at your own risk. It will most likely be tight so please plan on stacking crates etc. We reserve the right to rearrange spaces to fit additional crates as needed. Please contact us if you'd like to help out as an all day worker (vouchers paid for working) – we can typically work around you running dogs!

Demo Dogs:

If anyone has demo dogs available, please let us know!

Photographer:

If anyone would like to take photos of knows of someone who can take photos please let us know!

Late/Day of Show Entries:

As of 9/1, there are a few days/classes/levels with availability but most are full. Late and day of show entries may be available depending on entry counts at the time. Day of show entries must be turned in no later than 1 hour before the start of the trials. I'm staying on site so feel free to message me if you have an entry!

Wait-List & Pulled Entries:

As of 9/1, there is a small waitlist left for a few days/classes/levels. If you need to pull you may receive a refund/credit as per the policy listed in the premium. We will NOT be substituting entries for handlers who do not check in, you will be marked as absent if you miss your runs and the class closes out. Written notice (email or in person) must be given by 7am on the morning of the trial for all pulled entries in order to be eligible for a refund. See the premium for more information on the pull & refund policies.

Schedule:

Friday Detective Check-in starting at 7:30am, briefing at 7:45am, first dog to follow.

Estimated Check-in for all other classes starting at 8:30am, Briefing at 9:00am, walk-thrus & first dog to follow.

Runs for each judge to start after handler briefings.

A lunch and other breaks may be taken at the judge's and/or club's discretion.

Worker/judge dogs may be run before the briefing.

Class Order:

The exact running order for dogs will be fluid and dependent on search areas, conflicts, worker dogs, etc. Pre-entry counts are listed below.

Friday:

Giovanna will start with Detective and then go into Container/Buried Master.

Deanna will start with Container/Buried Excellent, and then go into Exterior Master, Exterior Excellent, Exterior Novice.

John will start with Exterior Advanced, Interior Advanced, and then Container/Buried Novice/Advanced.

Sally will start with Interior Master, Interior Excellent, and then Interior Novice.

Saturday:

Deanna will start with Interior Novice, and then go into Container/Buried Excellent and Container/Buried Master (we will try to have all four set up together).

Giovanna will start with Interior Master, Interior Excellent, and then Interior Advanced.

John will have Container/Buried Novice/Advanced open from around 9am until at least 12noon.

Sally will start with Exterior Master, Exterior Excellent, Exterior Advanced, and then Exterior Novice.

Sunday:

Sally will start with Interior Novice, and then go into Container/Buried Excellent and Container/Buried Master (we will try to have all four set up together).

Deanna will start with Interior Master, Interior Excellent, and then Interior Advanced.

John will have Container/Buried Novice/Advanced open from around 9am until at least 12noon.

Giovanna will start with Exterior Master, Exterior Excellent, Exterior Advanced, and then Exterior Novice.

But What Time Will My Class Start?

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

In the Regulations for AKC Scent Work (on the AKC website under "Scent Work" "Regulations Resources"), page 18 under Chapter 3 Section 22 it lists an estimated time per entry per class/level.

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, judge breaks, lunch breaks, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!

Conflicts:

We would like to accommodate each and every conflict but sometimes that is impossible and you may have to make a choice. Please notify us of your conflict BEFORE we are running your class so we can discuss how to best accommodate.

We cannot hold a class.

If you are not present by the time your class ends, you will not be able to run your dog in that class for that trial. A missed run cannot be moved to another day. Missed runs are not eligible for a refund.

Message Alerts:

Receive informational messages regarding these Scent Work Trials!
(Including what classes we are currently building/running.)

Download the "Remind" app. (Text messages no longer work!!)

Join the class- **ECKCSW2026**

- If asked "Are you a teacher, parent, or student" – text reply "S" for student.
- Make sure you are at least 13 years old if you make up a birthday. 😊
- Then your phone will receive messages of interest during the event.

Move-Ups:

Next day move-ups are offered if space is available. Move ups for the next trial must in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes that trial.

FROM THE SOUTH - From Hwy 85 take the 5th St exit & go west to 11th Ave. Proceed north on 11th Ave to park entrance.

FROM THE EAST OR WEST - From Hwy 34 Business Route take 11th Ave north to park entrance.

FROM INTERSTATE 25 NORTH OR SOUTH - Take Hwy 34 East to Business Hwy 34 exit, continue east to 11th Ave. Proceed north on 11th Ave to park entrance.
