

Front Range Scent Work Club AKC Scent Work Trials September 10-11-12, 2021

Location:

Hughes Supply, 1610 Vista View Dr, Longmont, CO 80504 See back page for map.

We will be using the outdoor fenced yard along with the office and warehouse sections of the building. Check in area will be through the main entrance in the lobby or just outside those doors depending on weather. DO NOT bring dogs into the front lobby unless you are queuing for a search area or an all day worker crating inside.

Please be sure to read any posted signs for important information!

Parking/Crating:

If you plan on idling your car, do not park in the spots up against the building. You will be asked to move. There is also street parking available. Last time we were also able to park in the lot across the street – we will send out a message if this is okay for these trials.

DO NOT PARK IN THE NEIGHBORING PARKING LOT TO THE WEST OF THE BUILDING. This business is open during the weekend. If you see anyone over there please help us out and let them know that they shouldn't be parked there. We do not want Hughes receiving complaints!

Due to space restrictions, crating will be out of your vehicles. Bring shades, fans, heaters, etc. No electricity will be provided. Canopies may be able to be set up depending on space, be sure to not block vehicle and emergency access. Please practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines and avoid congregating to the extent possible. Vehicles MUST fit in a legal parking spot.

Wait-List & Pulled Entries:

There is currently NO waitlist for these trials. See the premium for refund policies. Absent dogs <u>must be declared</u> in order for spots to be eligible to be filled by the waitlist. We will not pull dogs from the trial without notice being given in writing by the deadlines listed in the premium.

Schedule & Running Order:

The exact running order will be fluid and dependent on weather, conflicts, worker dogs, etc. Pre-entry counts are listed below.

Saturday and Sunday Donna is judging HD, Buried, and Exterior. Bonnie is judging Interior and Container. Judges will be running dogs at the same time in different areas.

If you are running multiple dogs and you aren't sure where to go first, ask!

Exterior and Buried will be run together. Interior and Containers will be run together. You'll run one set and then have a break before the other. If you need a break between the two elements in a set, just let us know.

Friday:

4:30pm - Check-in (DO NOT arrive earlier than this as the business is open until 4:30.)

4:45pm - Briefing & Walk Throughs

5:00pm - Start of HD (Master to Novice), followed by Container/Buried (run back to back, Novice to Master). Detective will run at the same time in a separate area.

Saturday/Sunday:

8:30am- Check-in starts (You do not need to arrive first thing in the morning to check in.) 9:00am – Briefing, Walk Throughs, first dog to follow.

Donna: HD will start Master → Novice, followed by Exterior/Buried: Excellent, Master and then Advanced, Novice.

Bonnie: Judging Interior/Container: Master, Excellent and then Novice, Advanced. Lunch and other breaks may be taken at the judge's and/or club's discretion.

But What Time Will My Class Start?

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

In the Regulations for AKC Scent Work (on the AKC website under "Scent Work" "Regulations Resources"), page 18 under Chapter 3 Section 22 it lists an estimated time per entry per class/level.

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, judge breaks, lunch breaks, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!

Move-Ups:

Next day move-ups are offered. Move ups for the next trial must be in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes that trial.

Text Message Alerts:

Receive informational text messages regarding Front Range Scent Work Trials! (Including what classes we are currently building/running.)

Text "@FRSWC-0921" (everything within the quotes, including the @) to the number 81010.

- o You will receive a text message asking to provide your full name.
- o If asked "Are you a teacher, parent, or student" text reply "S" for student.
- o Then your phone will receive text messages of interest during the event.

You do NOT have to download or utilize the software link suggested to receive our text messages on your phone!

If it asks for your birthday, just make sure you enter a date that makes you at least 13 years old.

*This text messaging system is primarily used by educators, so it may reference "classes", "teachers", and/or "students".

Miscellaneous Notes:

The buildings are climate controlled but there is no indoor crating available. Do not block business customer or emergency access with your vehicles / set-up.

Dogs must be kept on lead in keeping with the leash laws. Please also remember to respect other people's property!

Pottying: There is some grass areas outside the building. Please do not potty dogs in the small grassy landscaped area to the west of the building. Please do not hang out or set up chairs/tents in that area. Pay attention to marked areas so you aren't walking into a search area. Please be sure to pick up after your dog. Please keep your dog from peeing on the side of the building, or on any items that people have to pick up! Please clean up any accidents in the building immediately.

Food/Drinks: There are plenty of shops nearby for eating.

Bathrooms: There are bathrooms on site.
