



# Front Range Scent Work Club AKC Scent Work Trials May 13-14-15, 2022

## Location:

Hughes Supply, 1610 Vista View Dr, Longmont, CO 80504 **See back page for map.**

We will be using the outdoor fenced yard along with the office and warehouse sections of the building. **Check in area will be through the main entrance in the lobby or just outside those doors. DO NOT bring dogs into the front lobby unless you are queuing for a search area or an all day worker crating inside.**

**Please be sure to read any posted signs for important information!**

## Parking/Crating:

If you plan on idling your car, do not park in the spots up against the building. You will be asked to move. There is also street parking available. Last time we were also able to park in the lot across the street – we will send out a message if this is okay for these trials.

**DO NOT PARK IN THE NEIGHBORING PARKING LOT TO THE WEST OF THE BUILDING.** This business is open during the weekend. If you see anyone over there please help us out and let them know that they shouldn't be parked there. We do not want Hughes receiving complaints!

Due to space restrictions, crating will be out of your vehicles. Bring shades, fans, heaters, etc. No electricity will be provided. Canopies may be able to be set up depending on space, be sure to not block vehicle access. Vehicles **MUST** fit in a legal parking spot.

## Running Order:

The exact running order will be fluid and dependent on weather, conflicts, worker dogs, etc. Pre-entry counts are listed on the next page. If you are running multiple dogs and you aren't sure where to go first, ask! If you need a break between your two runs in a set, just let us know.

### Friday:

4:45pm – Briefing & Walk Throughs

Liz (Master, Excellent) → Start of HD, then Detective, then Container/Buried (run back to back).

John (Advanced, Novice) → Start of HD, then Container/Buried (run back to back).

8:30am- Check-in starts (You do not need to arrive first thing in the morning to check in.)

9:00am – Briefing, Walk Throughs (grouped as per the below), first dog to follow.

## Miscellaneous Notes:

There is no indoor crating available. Please be sure to not block business customer access with your vehicles / set-up. **DO NOT bring dogs into the front lobby unless you are queuing for a search area or an all day worker crating inside.**

**Water** is available but if you can please bring water jugs for dog water.

**Dogs** must be kept on lead in keeping with the leash laws. Please also remember to respect other people's property!

**Pottying:** There is some grass areas outside the building. **DO NOT** potty dogs in the small grassy landscaped area to the west of the building. Please do not hang out or set up chairs/tents in that area. Pay attention to marked areas so you aren't walking into a search area. Be sure to pick up after your dog. Please keep your dog from peeing on the side of the building, or on any items that people have to pick up! Clean up any accidents immediately.
