General Information: This is an ASCA sanctioned show and all ASCA rules apply (<u>www.asca.org</u>). Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available and proof of Rabies vaccination. High Plains ASC, the Show Secretary/ies and Club Membership and its Officers assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children, or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed at all times.

Entry Fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies, COVID flare-up, or other events beyond the control of High Plains ASC. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA programs or a person not in good standing with ASCA and/or High Plains ASC.

These events will be held indoors at the Matrix Dog, LLC Performance Center with heavy matting over concrete floor. Set-up space is somewhat limited. Electrical outlets are limited; please bring a power strip and extension cord(s) and plan to share. Please be considerate of others when setting-up. NO EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED (per Facility Owner.) All crates must have a mat/towel underneath covering the entire base of the crate to protect the matting. All Grooming Tables and all chairs (folding or otherwise) must have a mat/towel underneath table legs to protect the matting. Please do not drag equipment across the matting. The facility is cooled via swamp cooler. We encourage bringing fans (battery-operated or plug-in) to keep you and your dogs more comfortable.

IMPORTANT: Close-in parking is extremely limited!!! You are welcome to unload in front of the Matrix Dog unit (loading/unloading zone will be marked off with cones.) Then move your vehicle against the back fence or on the dirt parking down Deere Court. On Saturday/Sunday you can park on the side of the building and there will be more in front spots as the other two businesses are closed. Keep an eye on your dogs and valuables in vehicles and be sure to lock your doors. Dumpsters: Each dumpster is privately owned by each individual business. Please use <u>only</u> the dumpster by the garage door that is marked as "Matrix." There will be a garbage can outside of the front door for dog poo bags (please tie them) and garbage cans inside the building for other garbage.




