Parking:

IMPORTANT!!! Please leave the spots directly in front of Matrix for handicap parking, as marked handicap spots are limited. You can park your car against the back fence (NOT the one that opens to the propane yard) or on the dirt parking down Deere Court. After 6pm weekdays and also any time on Saturday/Sunday/holidays you can also park in the paved areas on the side of the building and there will be more in front spots as the other two businesses are closed. DO NOT BLOCK GARAGE DOORS. DO NOT PARK IN OTHER PARKING LOTS (the other buildings are owned by other parties). We are okay to double park in front of the autobody shop cars, they are usually closed on Saturday but will come find us if they need something moved.

Dumpsters:

Each dumpster is privately owned by each individual business. The Matrix dumpster is the one closest to the garage door. Please tie poop bags before throwing them in the dumpster. Do not dispose of used poop bags inside the building. There will be garbage cans inside the building for other garbage.

Late/Day-of-Show Entries:

If space is available. Check the Matrix Dog event page under "Current Run Availability" for a status (up until the day of the trials), or ask the Trial Secretary at the trials.

Move-Ups:

Move ups must in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes the class the dog is moving from.

Wait-List & Pulled Entries:

To check for run availability, see the Matrix Dog website event page under the "Current Run Availability" section, which will be updated as needed until the first day of the trials.

Refund policies are listed in the premium. Absent dogs <u>must be declared in writing</u> in order for spots to be eligible to be filled by the waitlist. We will not pull dogs from the trial without notice being given in writing.

Running Order:

The exact running order will be fluid and dependent on weather, conflicts, worker dogs, etc. Per AKC SW Rules (page 70), the trial may deviate from the published running order if a conflict exists or if it facilitates the smooth running of the trial. Pre-entry counts are listed in the "Pre-Entry Count" section below.

But What Time Will My Class Start?

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

In the Regulations for AKC Scent Work (on the AKC website under "Scent Work" "Regulations Resources"), page 18 under Chapter 3 Section 22 it lists an estimated time per entry per class/level.

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, judge breaks, lunch breaks, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!
