DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges(including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in theopinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort andcan safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visiblewounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enterso long asthe handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear tobe underundue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES

All entries must be legible or they will not be accepted. Late, incomplete, unsigned, unpaid or conditional entries, or entries not containing the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form will not be accepted.

BY MAIL: Complete an official AKC entry form for each dog (at the end of this premium). ONE ENTRY FORM PER DOG. A dog may only enter once per test. Mail completed forms with fees payable to Matrix Dog and send to 13120 Raritan Street, Westminster, CO 80234. Incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.

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<u>ONLINE</u>: Online entries will only be accepted from after event opening until the event is full. <u>WITHDRAWING ENTRIES & REFUNDS</u>: No entry fee will be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or banned from competition by the action of the field committee. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots,civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee for Test 1 but can participate in Test 2 at the very end of the event as the last dog(s). Notification in writing must begiven to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once thetime and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.


